I am delighted to share this Newsletter with you and provide an overview of the amazing work that has occurred in the first three months of the new financial year.

We have added three pain and palliative care clinics at three new areas in Delhi. The clinics have grown out of the understanding that despite the excellent home care service we provide, there are still unmet needs among the wider cancer population, especially those who are under active treatment.

We believe that palliative care education is an crucial public health approach to improving its utilisation. You will read about many educational activities that took place for both healthcare providers and communities to develop a comprehensive understanding of palliative care.

Finally, it was a landmark day for CanSupport as we launched our pilot project in Gurugram on 13 June 2023, towards development of a model integrating palliative care and symptom relief into primary health care so it is accessible by anyone in need. We are deeply grateful to Dr Sonia Trikha, DGHS Haryana, who paved the way for this pilot in Haryana. We are extremely thankful to

Dr Virender Yadav, Civil Surgeon Gurugram who took this on as a medical and ethical responsibility for preventing and relieving suffering due to serious or life-threatening health conditions. We greatly appreciate the support we have received from his office, lead by Dr Priya Sharma and backed by Dr Pallavi and Neeru.

PILOT FOR INTEGRATION OF PALLIATIVE CARE INTO THE PUBLIC HEALTH SYSTEM



On 12 June, CanSupport signed an MOU with the Civil Surgeon, Gurugram to run a 6-month pilot in its three rural sub district, which are high in cancer prevalence.

Under this project, CanSupport is going to implement a project in Pataudi Rural sub division of Gurugram district to integrate Palliative care with the prevailing public primary and secondary healthcare system from Primary Health Centre (PHC) level to district level towards overcoming fragmentation in Palliative care services at the community level.



Dr Sonia Trikha, Director General Health Services, Haryana, joined the inaugural session that boosted the project even further.



Since its inaugural session, 7 doctors, 9 Nursing Officers and 14 Community Health Officers from PHC Bhangrola, PHC Mandpura, Community Health Centre (CHC) Pataudi and District Civil Hospital, Gurugram have undergone intensive training on Palliative Care.

Community Health Officers, nurses and doctors of PHCs, CHC and District hospital, Gurugram have already started accompanying CanSupport staff on home visits. 168 ASHA and 42 ANM workers have also been successfully trained in PHC Bhangrola and CHC Pataudi.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS









OUTPATIENT CLINICS

CanSupport now runs five Outpatient Clinics and a Mobile Clinic in Delhi for providing Palliative care to patients. The patients are triaged in these OPCs and those who really require home care are referred to our home care teams. This is done to ensure that patients at an advanced stage or end of life can get maximum care in the comfort of their homes. Anyone undergoing cancer treatment can visit any of these clinics and can avail of our free palliative care that includes - symptom management, nursing support, free medication and psychosocial counselling.

Effective management of side effects enables patients to cope with their therapies and remain motivated to complete them. Comprehensive nursing care complemented with psychosocial and spiritual support to patients as well as their caregivers preserves the holistic nature of the care, even in an Outpatient set up, resulting in better treatment outcome.

The five clinics are located at the following locations in Delhi:

- North Delhi OPC: D7, Sushant Eye Care, Sector 6, Near Vishram Chowk, Rohini, Delhi – 110085
- East Delhi OPC: Delhi Bharat Bikas Foundation,
 PLOT -6 A, Facilitate Center, Opposite Sports
 Complex, Tiharpur, Dilshad Garden, Delhi 110093
- North East Delhi, Property No. 1, Main Road, Johripur, R.S.T. Enclave, Delhi - 110094
- Mobile Clinic, is stationed outside Safdarjung Hospital every Monday, Wednesday & Friday and outside Lok Nayak Jai Prakash Hospital every Tuesday & Thursday.





SMALL AID FUND

A 'Small Aid Fund' of amount Rs 10 lakh was established in CanSupport in 2021 under its Third Party Resource Facilitation program to support basic chemotherapy medication support in the treatment of cancer patients belonging to the economically weaker sections of society. The need for setting up Small Aid Fund was felt when there were a few cases every month under our Resource Facilitaion program where

patients did not have all documents required to avail government benefit schemes or whose documentary processes and approvals were delayed. This disrupted their treatment or put them in a position of not affording their treatment till the approvals were obtained. With a capping of Rs 10000/- per patient, the 'Small Aid Fund' helps fill this gap in starting their treatments timely, ensuring that no patient is left devoid of therapy due to lack of a small sum. In the last quarter under this program we were able to support 51 patients for amount Rs 106691/-.

NATIONAL ROUNDTABLE CONFERENCE ON ONCOLOGY

On 5 April, a team from CanSupport attended the National Roundtable Conference on Oncology, hosted by ECHO India in collaboration with the NCD division, Dte GHS, MoHFW. The gathering aimed at bringing together key stakeholders and opinion leaders from the field of Oncology and Cancer care to assess the most critical local and regional necessities of the workforce development in cancer care delivery. Also, to investigate approaches to upgrade training over the whole range of cancer care - from analysis to treatment, patient direction, backing, endurance, and palliative care.

'PHYSIOTHERAPY - PALLIATIVE CARE' INTERFACE

CanSupport participated in Indian Association of Palliative Care's Course in 'Physiotherapy – Palliative Care Interface' on 29 April. The aim of this course was to sensitize palliative care professionals about the benefits of integrating physiotherapy in their routine practice, so that every patient benefits from functional improvement and rehabilitation.



SESSIONS ON PALLIATIVE CARE

In the last quarter, the training team conducted sessions and workshops on 'Palliative care' for the students and faculty of Army Hospital - College of Nursing, Sant Parmanad School of Nursing, Kasturba Gandhi Hospital -School of Nursing and Enactus Club, Jamia Milia Islamia. A session on Palliative care was also held for the staff of HelpAge India, working in Tamil Nadu & Uttar Pradesh.

These workshops and sessions comprised theory, case studies and role play. The main focus in these workshops was CanSupport's holistic approach in providing Palliative care that gives patients and their families a chance to make informed choices. The 'low tech, high touch' approach in nursing was one major focal point.

These sessions and workshops are conducted in a fun interactive way, where the students are made to take part in role play to make learning experiential.
