

TRAINING, EDUCATION & RESEARCH

Pilot Project in collaboration with the Civil Surgeon Office, Gurugram

CanSupport completed the 6-month long pilot project in collaboration with Civil Surgeon office, Gurugram.

The Team held pilot activities at PHC Bhangrola, PHC Mandpura, CHC (&PHC) Pataudi and District Civil Hospital, Gurugram for setting up basic palliative care provision that can respond effectively to the palliative care needs of most patients in the area.

ABOUT EMPLOYEE ENGAGEMENT PROGRAM


CanSupport has been organizing Employee Engagement activities with Corporates since 2018. The employees have striven to give back to the society through both online and in-person activities.
